General Information: Location: The show will be held at the Middle School Gymnasium & Cafeteria located at 10109 Slee Road, Onsted. (Entrance is off Slee Rd. and Gym entrance is at the south end of the Middle School building)

Time: Set-Up will be Fri. 5-7:30 p.m. & Sat. beginning at 7:30 a.m. Doors will open to the public at 9:30 a.m. Saturday and remain open until 4:30 p.m. Your booth must remain open & manned for the duration of the show.

Craft Show: All items and crafts must be hand-made by you or your personal associates. All questionable items must be reviewed by the Craft Show committee before qualifying for the \$35 booth space price. We reserve the right to ask you to remove any items that are commercially made if you have paid the craft show entry fee.

Commercial Items: This includes commercially made, "purchased-for-resale" items, and mass produced items. It would also include assembled products and products from known business entities (i.e. Avon, Lia Sophia, etc....)

If you have not exhibited/sold with us before, we will review your booth photo and determine if you qualify for the craft show fee vs. the commercial booth fee.

General Information: Application: **All applications should be accompanied by a picture of your booth/items** along with your booth fee.

Deadline for apps is November 11, 2011 Refunds are not available after that date.
